He is the former president and publisher of Pilot Media, the parent company of *The Virginian-Pilot*. He has also served as deputy secretary of the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Obama administration and as Secretary of Commerce and Trade under the McAuliffe administration.

Maurice grew up on a tobacco farm in Kenbridge, Virginia, a small rural town where he was raised by his grandparents. He credits this upbringing as the genesis of his strong work ethic and his desire to help people.

It's this desire to help people and their communities that attracted him to the

new position at WHRO. He has seen how journalism can help individuals as well as society as a whole. He recounted one story from his days at *The Virginian-Pilot*. The newspaper ran a series of articles about suicides among Navy personnel. He received an email from a reader who shared what the series meant to her.

"She said, 'I want to thank you for the series that you wrote; it saved my life,'" he recalled. "She said, 'I was contemplating taking my life. I felt pretty hopeless. Your series is what gave me the strength to seek help."

He also feels high-quality journalism is essential to maintain the nation's status as a high-functioning democracy.

"The prerequisite of us having a successful democracy is having an enlightened citizenry and holding our leaders, both in the public and private sectors, accountable for their decisions and behaviors," he explained. "Journalism and a free press do that, and have been doing that, better than almost anything else I know."

Though many of his previous positions took place on a national stage, he said he is very excited to be working at the local level once again.



"The most impactful decisions on people's opportunities are those that happen locally," he explained. "Healthy journalism not only holds local leaders accountable, but also helps leaders make good decisions about issues that affect citizens, such as schools, transportation, childcare, jobs and healthcare."

In a culture where some perceive bias in media—accusing media outlets of leaning either too far left or too far right politically—Maurice said he understands the responsibility that falls on news leaders to maintain objectivity and accuracy in their organization's reporting. "I know that the most important currency for an enterprise that is aspiring to deliver journalism is trust," he said. "We have to get up every day and earn and re-earn trust."

It is a mission that he takes seriously and is looking forward to.

"I think some folks will look at my professional journey and say, well, he must be biased in favor of some cause that Democrats pursue or what have you, so I need to be sensitive to that. I need to make sure that I am doing everything I can to follow the truth, to hold us to that standard, and that's what I'll do," he said.

WHRO President & CEO Bert Schmidt cited Maurice's extensive background and his passion for both the community and journalism as a powerful combination for the organization. "I am thrilled to have Maurice join WHRO," Bert said. "As we continue to uphold our commitment to delivering high-quality and impactful local journalism, we are confident that he will play a pivotal role in leading our newsroom to new heights."

Maurice's most immediate goal is to work on ways to grow and sustain the award-winning journalism that WHRO is already known for.

"We want a journalistic endeavor that can cover southeast Virginia, and do so comprehensively, and do so in a way that's financially sustainable," he said. "In the next six months, I want to build on the incredible progress already made with a particular focus on scaling and growing."

It's a challenging undertaking, and one that he is eager to begin.

"We want to be the preeminent local journalistic enterprise in this region. When people think of where they should go for great journalism in this area, we want to be at the top of that list."

Paul Shugrue Celebrates 20 Years at WHRO Public Media

WHRO Public Media is celebrating the 20th anniversary of Paul being on the station's airwaves—and of his incredibly popular program, *Out of the Box*.

Paul said he has been working in radio "since the prehistoric era of vinyl records when you had to worry about the song you're playing skipping or getting stuck in one groove. Ah, those were the days!" His first gig was at WUVT, the student radio station at Virginia Tech.

He has listened to music all of his life, but as a teenager, one particular genre caught his attention. "I discovered the so-called progressive rock stations. They were so cool I wanted to be like them," he explained.

He hasn't looked back since those early days at Tech's student radio station.

"Radio was a very competitive field when I first started," he said. "I worked my way up from small markets in Virginia to where I am now. I feel fortunate to be in my position and to play what I want to play on the air."

He has also enjoyed some very exhilarating opportunities while on the job. "I had the thrill of hosting a couple of morning show broadcasts from Abbey Road Studios in London back in the '80s, and I also did radio reports from Live Aid in Philadelphia in 1985," he recalled. He has also enjoyed interviewing local and national artists.

But hosting *Out of the Box* has been his overarching achievement to date.

"It's a unique show that fills a void of music that had been missing from the radio, and I get to do it in the style of those oh-socool progressive rock jocks," he said.

The program promises to keep listeners up to date on all the great new music that's being released but rarely played on the radio anywhere else.

"I've been really encouraged by the consistent support the show has gotten in terms of membership donations," Paul said. "People seem to like hearing something new on the radio!"

Fans also enjoy live performances. Ten years ago, Paul began the 'Out of the Box Emerging Artists Concert Series' in partnership with the Sandler Center for the Performing Arts in Virginia Beach. Each winter, he hosts free weekly concerts with new artists, and they have become quite popular.

Congratulations, Paul, on an incredible 20 years of *Out of the Box* and 10 years of bringing great concerts to our community. We look forward to many more!
