# **Music Spotlight: The Vocal Sound of Jazz**



Hampton Roads Public Radio was in its infancy when Jack Frieden began producing *The Vocal Sound of Jazz*. This year marks 43 years it has been heard over the airwaves here, and for a time, over WUOM in Ann Arbor, Michigan. The program originally aired for 30 minutes on Friday nights. It later expanded to an hour and moved to Saturday evenings where it's been a favorite of listeners for years. Jack was first introduced to jazz during his post college years while living in Washington. He says, "DC had a thriving vibrant music scene and the interest in jazz vocal music was a natural progression of my deep love of the vocals of The Beach Boys, Crosby, Stills and Nash, and The Beatles." Jack returned to Hampton Roads and became a featured writer on music for both the *Virginian-Pilot* and *Metro Magazine*. *The Vocal Sound of Jazz* came soon after, and it now has been on the air longer than any other locally produced WHRV program.

Jack says he firmly believes that vocal jazz can serve as a gateway for people to explore more jazz and he loves showcasing jazz vocalists interpreting contemporary music—and emphasizing that the music itself is a living art form.

During his years of being involved in music, he's had a long interview with Graham Nash; sat next to Art Garfunkel and Carly Simon at a party honoring the legendary Jimmy Webb; and formed his own record label, VSOJAZ Records, with releases by Diane Hubka and Laura Martier. He maintains a website that features reviews new releases and spotlights news of the genre. And perhaps most important to jazz enthusiasts, each Saturday night, he provides a relaxing evening of great music on the *The Vocal Sound of Jazz* on WHRV 89.5 FM.

# The Future is Female

This being Women's History Month, it might be interesting to take a look (and listen) to how far women composers have come in classical music radio. I'm happy to say they have come a very long way, and classical music radio and the compact disc have definitely helped pave the way.

Back in ancient times (my early radio years), one could only find a trace here and there of women composers being featured on classical discs (LPs at the time). A check of an old 1966 Schwann classical record catalog found one Clara Schumann, two Amy Beach discs, one Cecile Chaminade and one Lili Boulanger. Pretty slim pickings in those days.

Time shift to 2023. A recent disc I featured on my Saturday *This Just In* 

program is entitled *The Future is Female*. They got that right. All the way from the twelfth century to today, music by women is pouring forth. The amazing Abbess Hildegard von Bingen (1098-1179) is constantly being recorded and performed (playing her works assuredly makes WHRO FM an "oldies station"). When you tune us in, it is nothing to hear the baroque sounds of Barbara Strozzi or an overture from Felix Mendelssohn's wonderfully talented sister Fanny.

Symphonies aren't just for the guys anymore. Check out some impressive Romantic era symphonies by Louise Farrenc and Emilie Mayer. You want an amazing musical polymath? Consider Teresa Carreño, who lived from 1853 to 1917. She was a composer, a famous singer, a pianist and a conductor! Want a women's lib pioneer? Try the formidable Dame Ethel Smyth of England.

For many years, we had world-renowned composer Thea Musgrave living here in Norfolk composing world-class operas. Not very long ago, the Old Dominion University Symphony Orchestra played a symphony by Florence Price, whose fame has blossomed and whose works have entered the standard repertoire. Pulitzer Prize-winning composer Caroline Shaw has performed her music with the Virginia Symphony, and they have also brought us composers like Jessie Montgomery and Anna Clyne with music director Eric Jacobsen conducting, concerts which we were privileged to broadcast.
